

[PRE-CONFERENCE ACTIVITY] - Mar 11, 2013 Facility Tour to Macau: Macao Science Center & The House of Dancing Water Theater backstage

<u>Macao Science Center</u> is designed by the world renowned architect Mr. I.M.Pei and Pei Partnership Architects. The reclamation works and its support facilities was officially kicked off on December 1, 2005. Through over 3 years of construction and preparation, Macao Science Center was completed in 2009.

Facilities of the Macao Science Center include Exhibition Center, Planetarium and Convention Center.

- Exhibition Center: The 5,800 square meters Exhibition Center and its 14 galleries can accommodate over 450 interactive exhibits. All exhibitions feature knowledge, science and fun-oriented interactive exhibits, allowing visitors a hands-on way to explore science.
- Planetarium: The centerpiece of the Planetarium is a tilted semi-dome screen nearly 15 meters in diameter, supported by high resolution 3D digital projectors. The Planetarium has around 127 seats equipped with interactive controls. Its powerful database, coupled with the amazing projection effects, can take viewers on a journey traveling freely into space.
- Convention Center: The 700 square meter Convention Center includes a multi-functional convention hall and four small meeting rooms. The multi-functional convention hall is equipped with professional audio visual facilities.

The <u>House of Dancing Water Theater</u> is the first advanced technology, purposebuilt theater to house the world's largest and most spectacular water-based show.

Designed by world-renowned architects Pei Partnership and scenic designer Michel Crete, the Theater contains one of the largest commercial pools in the world which is 50 meters in diameter, 10 meters deep and holds 4.5M gallons of water. The 270-degree theater in the round has a central stage with a diameter of approximately 25 meters (82 ft.), surrounded by sloped seating on three sides for as many as 2,000 theater patrons. Eleven elevators located in the pool transform the 22m diameter central section of the pool into a dry stage within 1 minute.
