

GUIDED TOUR

HK Electric Natural Gas-fired Generating Unit

Lamma Power Station was commissioned in 1982 and it generates electricity for customers in Hong Kong Island and Lamma Island. Developed in four stages, it has an installed capacity of 3,737MW, which includes both coal-fired and gas-fired generating units.

As part of HK Electric's drive to reduce emissions, Lamma Power Station continued with efforts to increase the proportion of natural gas and cleaner fuels in its fuel mix. The first gas-fired combined cycle unit was commissioned in 2006 and over 30% of the Company's power generation comes from natural gas.
