### Session 1

## Promotion of Waste Reduction and Recycling in Hong Kong

As outlined in the "Hong Kong Blueprint for Sustainable Use of Resources 2013-2022" ("the Blueprint") published in May 2013, the Government is determined to proactively engage the community in tackling the waste challenges in Hong Kong. The Government have laid out a clear strategy for taking multiple and concurrent actions to encourage waste reduction at source, enhance reuse and recovery of resources as well as promote clean recycling. A number of initiatives cover broad perspectives have been rolled out on multiple fronts to promote waste reduction and recycling, as well as to facilitate the recycling industry to upgrade its operational standard and efficiency.

The session covers the on-going and new initiatives of the government including promotion of waste reduction and recycling in the community, promotion of clean recycling, infrastructure support for recycling industry, establishment of Recycling Fund, green procurement, strengthening support for recycling of waste plastic, enhancing outreaching service to promote waste reduction and recycling, promoting the development of local manufacturing industry using recycled materials, etc.

Mr. Steven WONG, Senior Environmental Protection Officer, is the section head of the Waste Reduction and Recycling Section of the Environmental Protection Department, HKSAR Government. He has over 25 years of experience in a wide range of environmental management works including waste facilities planning and administration, environmental legislation enforcement, waste management policy formulation and waste reduction and recycling promotion. His current responsibilities include promoting the sustainable development of recycling industry, formulating policy and land support measures for the recycling operations and collaborating with District Councils in promoting waste reduction and recycling in the community.

### Case Sharing on Environmental Compliance Matters

Focus mainly on the environmental compliance matters under the concerned Credits in the Site Aspects and the Materials Aspects.
