#### Background

The energy industry and society at large are facing rapid changes which in part are due to the transition of energy from a hydrocarbon based commodity to one which has diverse sources with increasing elements of sustainability. The way we consume energy in our daily lives is changing rapidly with altering patterns of consumption, which may no longer match the tradition concepts of supply. Our whole economy is inevitably moving towards a circular, sustainable economy driven by our changing lifestyle. We intend to not only explore how the energy supply industry is changing, but also changes in the way society consumes energy and what we as energy professionals are doing to meet the challenges ahead. Regional, cross-border and multi-disciplinary collaboration of energy professionals is required to achieve this goal.

- how the industry is developing new technologies to meet the energy transition challenge
